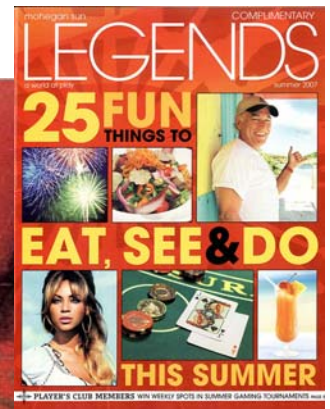

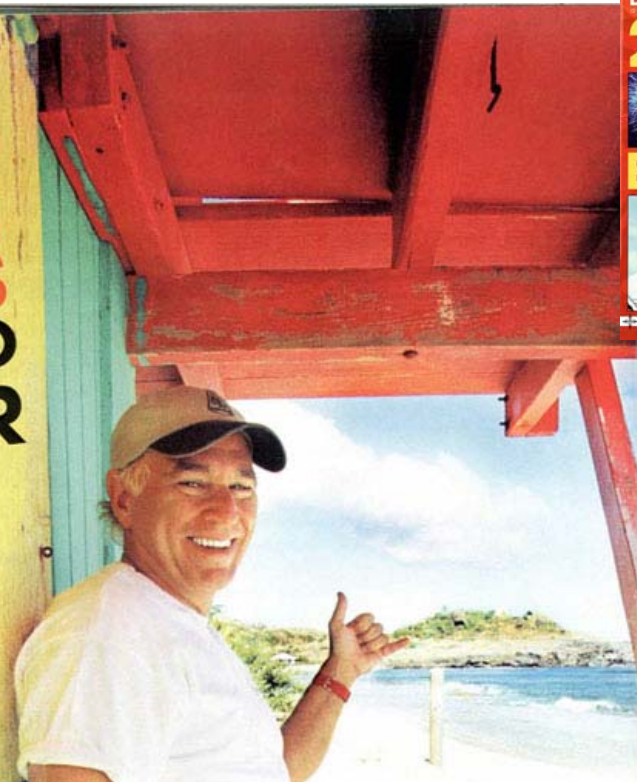

The **Tropical Lifesaver** (left) blends Malibu coconut rum with mango and pineapple rums and orange, cranberry and pineapple juices. The **Sunset Margarita** mixes Partida tequila, Cointreau and Grand Marnier with sour mix and dash of cranberry and orange juices. For a taste of South America, try their **Caipirinha**, which combines fresh mint muddled with lime, soda and Brazilian Leblon cachaca with simple syrup, lemon and a splash of Chambord.
